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Quasiflats in hierarchically hyperbolic spaces

Hierarchically hyperbolic spaces provide a uniform framework for working with many important examples, including mapping class groups, right angled Artin groups, Teichmuller space, and others. In this talk I'll provide an introduction to studying groups and spaces from this point of view and discuss some new results about quasiflats in this context.
